The most important job to do as a scientist is to get his identifications or fundamentally astonishing changes which have an incredible impact on our daily life out against all odds though he will have to mobilize all ways and manners to get away with it.

This does not mean that identifying amazing scientific relations or exploring unknown fields thereby acquiring social contributions aren't crucial. To suggest scientific new findings that will support an individual's personal daily life and consequently enhance overall society to many people, especially ones doing influential works such as politicians, doctors, environmentalists and so on, is no less important than to find out novel identifications. In other words, scientists must be eager to popularize their astonishing outcomes too. Then, how they can inform people of their scientifically amazing and socially supportive findings?

(B)

One possibility of representing them opens as they accept to interview with reporters or to give a lecture about their accomplishments to many people. There is another way of it that non-experts communicate scientific findings difficult to understand to other people through experiments and other interesting manners. For example, Heopop, known for an experiment breaking down hydrogen peroxide, delivers a lot of scientific information through YouTube videos, performing experiments, even if it can be inaccurate. In Geekble, a member requires other members to make a scientific work, and the completed work is presented through edited video which additional professional expositions were inserted into. Also, Science Cookie, a former physics teacher, explains superficially very difficult phenomena using colorful pictures and texts so that we could understand it very well.

(C)

A scholar who has succeeded in finding out many likely-to-be contributive findings and determining several earth-breaking things or something socially as well as scientifically valuable but doesn't try to represent his accomplishments to the public instead enjoys the delight and convenience emerging from them by himself or at best with a few scientists does anything he can do other than serving the rest and society.
